RULES

- This is a solo competition
- Participants will be shown 30 original plant samples, out of these, any 25 must be identified correctly
Participants must mention both English and Hindi names of the identified plants along with its habitat , uses and values.
- Design a self-created symbol that visually represents its exclusive or most important use (e.g. healing, water retention, immunity booster, etc.)
- Symbols must be creative, relevant, and self-explanatory (students can give a one-line reason for the symbol if asked)
- All information must be recorded on chart paper in a structured format provided on the spot
- Judges will randomly select 3 plants for an on-the-spot explanation, asking students to justify their symbol and plant use
- Only chart paper will be provided by the host school
- All other stationery (sketch pens, symbols, plant fact references, etc.) must be arranged by participants
- Bonus points for integrating real-world applications (e.g., eco-sustainability, ayurvedic value, environmental impact)

RULES

- ▶ Hand stitching is mandatory for all patchwork, layering, or fabric-based attachments
- ▶ Glue may be used only for sticking elements like rope or decorative add-ons, where stitching is not feasible
- ▶ Artwork should be clearly aligned with the selected theme and must be presented on A3 size fabric
- ▶ Maximum weightage will be given for the use of a wide variety of textile material (e.g., jute, lace, felt, wool, denim, net, cotton, rope, etc.)
- ▶ Creative integration of patchwork, layering, and texture is encouraged
